## Welcome to the 2024-2025 School Year!

The 2024 FCCLA Fall Leadership Conference, planned for October 6-7, 2024, will offer something for all members as well as something special for you as the adviser! Here are some of the specifics of the two-day leadership training.

<u>Registration</u>: \$50 for each person attending – must include advisers, chaperones and students. Registration costs cover 2 meals (Monday breakfast and lunch), workshop expenses, speaker fees/expenses, etc.

<u>Hotel Rates</u>: \$89.99/room + tax. There have been 94 rooms reserved for our group. Any unused rooms in this block will be released 9 days prior to the meeting. Check in is at 3 PM and check out is at 11 AM on the day of departure. Make all hotel reservations directly with the hotel and let them know you are a part of our group.

<u>Time Commitment & Schedule</u>: Activities will take place on Sunday 5:00 PM – 9:30 PM (5:00 PM start for Leadership Team Training) & Monday 8 AM – 2:45 PM. Check-In & Registration will begin at 4:00 PM. Sunday night curfew is 10:30 p.m. Please have students eat supper before the Sunday night sessions begins.

## **Conference Workshop Sessions:**

Rookie Training — This conference option is especially for new and incoming members to learn more about FCCLA and the opportunities available throughout the year in the organization. Sessions will include introducing members to FCCLA programs and developing leadership skills through engaging and interactive activities.

<u>Power Training</u> –This conference option is for chapter officers and returning members. Students will develop skills to prepare them for serving, leading, and inspiring others through FCCLA activities and programs. <u>Code of Conduct/Photography Release/Medical Release</u>: Students must complete Code of Conduct & Photography Consent/Medical Release form.
